### APPOINTMENTS.

Ootacamund, May 14, 1897.

No. 268.—Mr. Graham Warburton Elphinstone to be Special Assistant to the Collector, District Magistrate and Agent to the Governor, Ganjam, under paragraph 25 of the Madras Famine Code.

No. 269.—Mr. Neil Macmichael to be Special Assistant to the Collector and Magistrate of the district, Anantapur, under paragraph 25 of the Madras Famine Code.

No. 270.—Mr. Philip Joseph Pope to be Special Assistant to the Collector and Magistrate of the district, Kurnool, under paragraph 25 of the Madras Famine Code.

No. 271.—Mr. William Watkin Phillips to be Assistant and to act as Sub-Collector, Joint Magistrate and Principal Assistant to the Collector, Magistrate and Government Agent, Godavari.

(3) *The foot-path from Chakicherla to the Bay of Bengal* to a width of one yard for men only.—This enters the reserve five and a half chains north-east of the north-east corner of survey No. 369 of Chakicherla, and running in an easterly direction for about four furlongs leaves it on the sea coast.

*Note.*—This will also be allowed as a cart-track to a width of four yards from its entrance up to the Buckingham canal.

II.—Survey Nos. 7, 17 and 18-A of Chakicherla, measuring 6.84, 0.31 and 2.97 acres, respectively, have been ordered to be demarcated out and retained as enclosures within the reserve free from reservation with access by the path from Chakicherla to the Bay of Bengal up to the Buckingham canal, then along the canal bank and thence by foot and cattle paths from the nearest point eastwards to the fields.

III.—The Buckingham canal as demarcated out by the Public Works Department will be excluded from reservation.

No. 209.—His Excellency the Governor in Council is pleased to declare under the provisions of section 16 of the Madras Forest Act (V of 1882), that, from the 31st July 1897, the areas, the boundaries of which are set forth in the schedule appended to this notification shall be constituted "reserved forests."
