**Madras Forest Act—Reserved forests—Limits  
redefined.**

*Fort St. George, June 23, 1939.*

**No. 515.**

In exercise of powers conferred by sub-section (4) of section 17-A of the Madras Forest Act, 1882 (Madras Act V of 1882), His Excellency the Governor of Madras is hereby pleased to redefine the limits of Shannamangalam reserved forest, Malabar district, so as to remove the defects in the description of the limits of the said forest in Revenue Department Notification No. 559, dated the 24th November 1892, published at page 1527 of Part I of the *Fort St. George Gazette*, dated the 6th December 1892, by making the following correction to the limits of the said forest:—

**CORRECTION.**

For the schedule to the said notification, the following schedule shall be substituted, namely:—

**SCHEDULE.**

*Malabar district, Wynaad taluk, Tirunelli amsam,  
Trissaleri desam.*

[Name of forest—XIII. Shannamangalam reserved forest. Area in acres—437-50.]

**Boundaries.**

*North.*—Starting from the north-east corner of Survey No. 568/1 (Edacode reserved forest) of Trissaleri desam, on the southern side of the Manantoddy-Mysore Road, the boundary line runs eastwards along the south margin of the said road till it meets the north-west corner of Survey No. 597/6.

*East.*—Thence the line runs south-west along the west sides of Survey Nos. 597/6, 596 and 597/5, till it meets the north-west corner of Survey No. 591 (trijunction of Survey Nos. 597/5, 591 and 597/4-A); thence westwards along the north side of Survey No. 597/4-A to the northernmost corner of Survey No. 578; thence along the west and south sides of Survey No. 578 and the south sides of Survey No. 579 to the southernmost corner of the last-mentioned field; thence along the west side of Survey No. 588, to the north-east corner of Survey No. 580/2; thence along its north, west and south sides to its southernmost corner; thence along the west side of Survey No. 588 again to the southernmost corner of Survey No. 587; thence eastwards along a part of its south side and south-westwards along the west side of Survey No. 588 again to the northernmost corner of Survey No. 586; thence along its north and west sides to its south-west corner.

*South.*—Thence the line runs westwards along the north side of Survey Nos. 584, 583, 582, 581, 597/1-B and 576 till it meets the south-east corner of Survey No. 577; thence along its east, north and west sides to its south-west corner.

*West.*—Thence the boundary line runs along the north sides of Survey No. 576 again, east sides of Survey No. 573 and the east and north sides of Survey No. 572 to the northernmost point of the last-mentioned field on the east side of Survey No. 568/1 (Edacode reserved forest) and thence along its east sides to the starting point of the northern boundary.

**NOTE.**—The reserve comprises the following survey numbers of Trissaleri desam:—

597/1-A, 597/2, 597/3 and 580/1.

**Remarks.**—The following right of way has been admitted in this reserved forest:—

A cart-track 10 yards wide and 15 chains long for people, cattle and carts entering the reserve on the north boundary at mile 59/14 from the Manantoddy-Mysore Road and running due southwards to the northernmost point of S. No. 578 where it leaves the reserve.

In exercise of powers conferred by sub-section (4) of section 17-A of the Madras Forest Act, 1882 (Madras Act V of 1882), His Excellency the Governor of Madras is hereby pleased to redefine the limits of Edacode reserved forest, Malabar district, so as to remove the defects in the description of the limits of the said forest in Revenue Department Notification No. 559, dated the 24th November 1892, published at pages 1527 to 1533 of Part I of the *Fort St. George Gazette*, dated the 6th December 1892, by making the following corrections to the limits of the said forest:—

**SCHEDULE.**

*Malabar district, Wynaad taluk, Tirunelli amsam,  
Trissaleri desam.*

[Name of forest—XII. Edacode reserved forest. Area in acres—176-62.]

**Boundaries.**

*North.*—Starting from the north-east corner of Survey No. 491 (Kartikulam reserved forest) on the south side of Survey No. 567 which is a subdivision of the Manantoddy-Mysore Road, the boundary line runs along the south side of the said road till it meets the north-west corner of Survey No. 597 (Shannamangalam reserved forest).

*East.*—Thence the line runs southwards along the west side of Survey No. 597 (Shannamangalam reserved forest) till it meets the north side of Survey No. 572; thence along the north and west sides of Survey No. 572 and the west sides of Survey No. 573 to the northernmost corner of Survey No. 575; thence along the north, west and south sides of that number to its south-east corner; and thence along the west sides of Survey No. 576 to the north-east corner of Survey No. 570.

*South.*—Thence the line runs westwards along the north sides of Survey No. 570 to the south-east corner of Survey No. 571; thence along its east, north and west sides to its south-west corner; thence along the north side of Survey No. 570; again to the south-east corner of Survey No. 569; thence along its east and north sides to its north-west corner; thence along the north sides of Survey Nos. 568/2 and 568/6 till it meets the east side of Survey No. 498.

*West.*—Thence the line runs along the east and north sides of Survey No. 498 to the point where it meets the eastern boundary of Survey No. 491 again (Kartikulam reserved forest); thence along the east sides of this number and Survey No. 500 to the easternmost corner of the last-mentioned field; thence along parts of the south and east sides of Survey Nos. 508, 509 and 512 to the north-east corner of the last-mentioned field; thence along the east sides of Survey No. 491 again and No. 515 to the south-west corner of Survey No. 516; thence along its south, east and north sides to its north-west corner; thence along the east and north sides of Survey No. 517 to the south-east corner of Survey No. 518; thence along the east sides of Survey Nos. 518 and 491 again to the starting point.

**NOTE.**—The reserve comprises the whole of S. No. 568/1 of Trissaleri desam.

**Remarks.**—The following right of way has been admitted in this reserved forest:—

A cart-track 10 yards wide and 14 chains long for people, cattle and carts entering the reserve at the south-east corner of S. No. 565 (Manantoddy-Mysore Road) and running generally southwards to the northernmost point of S. No. 572 where it leaves the reserve.

**No. 517.**

Whereas the Hilledale, Chammattimalai and Hilledale Additions I to XI reserved forests have been amalgamated into a single reserved forest known as the Hilledale reserved forest;

And whereas the description of the limits of the Hilledale reserved forest, as amalgamated, is not clear in reference to existing facts;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (4) of section 17-A of the Madras Forest Act, 1882 (Madras Act V of 1882), and in supersession of the notifications specified below, His Excellency the Governor of Madras is hereby pleased to redefine the limits of the Hilledale reserved forest

to make the description clear in reference to existing facts by making the following correction to the limits of the said forest:—

Revenue Department Notification No. 501, dated the 27th August 1914, published at page 1301 of Part I of the Fort St. George Gazette, dated 15th September 1914, and Development Department Notification No. 205, dated the 24th March 1938, published at page 472 of Part I of the Fort St. George Gazette, dated the 20th March 1938.

**CORRECTION.**

For the Schedule to Revenue Department Notification No. 559, dated the 24th November 1892, published at page 1527 of Part I of the Fort St. George Gazette, dated the 6th December 1892, the following Schedule shall be substituted, namely:—

**SCHEDULE.**

*Malabar district, Wynaad taluk, Tirunelli amsam, Tirunelli desam.*

[Name of forest—Hilldale. Area in acres—7,478.72.]

**Boundaries.**

**North.**—Starting from the westernmost corner of Survey No. 44/1 of Tirunelli desam (Tirunelli reserve) the boundary line runs along the south sides of the said Survey No. 44/1 till it meets the south sides of Survey No. 45 (Woodstock reserve now amalgamated with Tirunelli reserved forest); thence along the south and east (part) sides of that number to the south side of Survey No. 46 at the trijunction of Survey Nos. 45, 46 and 1; thence along the south sides of Survey Nos. 46 and 44/1 along the Bavali river till it meets the north side of Survey No. 286; thence along the north, west and south sides of that number to the south-west corner of Survey No. 291 where it again meets the Bavali river; thence along the south bank of the said river (which coincides with the south side of Survey No. 291) to the westernmost corner of Survey No. 301; thence along the west sides of Survey Nos. 301 and 300 to the northernmost corner of Survey No. 289; thence along the north, west, south and east (part) sides of that number to the south side of Survey No. 301 again and thence along that side to the north-west corner of Survey No. 302. Thence the line runs along the west and south sides of Survey Nos. 302 and 303 to the south-east corner of the latter number; thence along the south sides of Survey Nos. 304 and 305 to the northernmost corner of Survey No. 306; thence along the west sides of that number and the south side of Survey No. 307 to the southernmost corner of the last mentioned field; thence along the west sides of Survey No. 308, north and west sides of Survey No. 313, west side of Survey No. 312 and the west, south and east sides of Survey No. 311 to the north-east corner of the last mentioned field at the trijunction of Survey Nos. 310, 311 and 312; thence along the south sides of Survey No. 310 and the south and east sides of Survey No. 305 till it again meets the Bavali river, thence crossing the river the line runs along the north bank of the river (which coincides with the south sides of Survey Nos. 250, 249, 248 and 247) and along the south-west side of Survey No. 247, crossing the said river, and the west and south sides of Survey No. 246 to the southernmost corner of the last mentioned field; thence along the west side of Survey No. 245 and the west, south and east sides of Survey No. 325 to the westernmost corner of Survey No. 326; thence along the south sides of Survey Nos. 326, 328 and 332 (which lies between Survey Nos. 328 and 329) and the south and east sides of Survey No. 329 and the south sides of Survey No. 330 to the north-west corner of Survey No. 331; thence along the west and south sides of that number, the west side of Survey No. 332 (which lies between Survey Nos. 331 and 343) and the west, south and east sides of Survey No. 343 and the south sides of Survey No. 344 to the westernmost corner of Survey No. 346; thence along the south sides of that number and the west and south sides of Survey No. 347 and the south sides of Survey Nos. 348, 349 and 350 and the east sides of Survey Nos. 350 and 345 to the easternmost corner of the last mentioned field and thence along the south side of Survey No. 399/3 to the north-west corner of Survey No. 353.

**East.**—Thence the line runs southwards along the west sides of Survey Nos. 353 and 352 till it meets the Tirunelli-Trissaleri desam boundary.

**South.**—Thence the line runs westwards along the northern boundaries of Trissaleri, Vemom and Tindummal desams till it meets the eastern boundary of the Kottayam taluk.

**West.**—Thence along the said boundary of the Kottayam taluk to the starting point.

The Hilldale reserve comprises the whole of S. Nos. 1, 2, 297, 298, 314 to 319, 320/2, 320/3, 321 to 324 and 351 of Tirunelli amsam and desam.

**Remarks.**

The following survey number of Tirunelli desam is admitted as an enclosure within this block:—

(1) Survey No. 320/1 of 19.20 acres in extent.

(2) The following rights of way are admitted in this reserve:—

(i) A path 10 yards wide and 36 chains long for people, cattle and carts entering the reserve at the south-west corner of S. No. 329 and running generally in a south-westerly direction to a point 3 chains south of the north-eastern corner of S. No. 320/1.

(ii) A path 10 yards wide and 1 mile long for people and cattle only entering the reserve at a point two chains east of the south-west corner of S. No. 329 and running generally southwards and leaving the reserve at a point on the Trissaleri desam boundary 35 chains west of the north-western corner of S. No. 7 of Trissaleri desam.

(3) The Jain and Bet Kurumbers residing in this block are permitted to continue to enjoy their present privileges as tenants-at-will of the Forest department.

**Rule under Madras Co-operative Societies Act  
Draft amendment.**

The following draft of an amendment to the rules made under the Madras Co-operative Societies Act, 1932 (Act VI of 1932), published with Development Department Notification No. 264, dated the 1st August 1933, at pages 1178-1185 of Part I of the Fort St. George Gazette, dated the 1st August 1933, as subsequently amended, which the Government of Madras propose to make in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-sections (1) and (2) of section 65 of the said Act is hereby published as required by sub-section (3) of the said section, for the information of all persons likely to be affected thereby.

Notice is hereby given that the draft will be taken into consideration on or after the 4th August 1939 and that any objection or suggestion which may be received with respect thereto from any person before the date aforesaid will be considered by the Government of Madras.

**DRAFT AMENDMENT.**

The following shall be added as clause (iv) of rule XXIV:—

“(iv) Notwithstanding anything contained in clauses (i) to (iii), the Registrar may, by order in writing, permit the by-laws of a society to be amended by such smaller body representing the members of the society as may be prescribed in the rules or in the by-laws of the society. In such cases, all references to general body meetings contained in clauses (i) to (iii) shall be construed as references to the meetings of such smaller body.”
