





NOTIFICATIONS.

Fort St. George, November 22, 1906.

No. 444.—The Governor in Council is pleased to declare, under the provisions of section 16 of the Madras Forest Act, 1892 (Madras Act V of 1882) that, from the 1st March 1906, the area, the boundaries of which are set forth in the schedule annexed to this notification, shall be a "reserved forest".

and Kottayam taluk, the boundary runs along that boundary to the Coorg-Kottayam-Wynaad junction. *East.*—Thence it runs along the boundary between the Wynaad and Kottayam taluks to the point where that boundary is crossed by the Kuppattaran or Kunduthodu. *South.*—Thence along the right bank of the Kuppattaran or Kandathodu to the junction of this thodu with the Kuradanpoya; thence along the right bank of the latter to its junction with the Eduvaranthodu. *West.*—Thence the boundary runs along the left bank of the Eduvaranthodu for a distance of about three miles in a north-north-easterly direction and crosses it reaching cairn No. 1 at the point near its source where it is joined by the Kotancherithodu; thence north-north-west for twenty-two yards to cairn No. 2; thence north-north-east for forty-three yards to cairn No. 3; thence north-east for thirty-three yards to cairn No. 4; thence east-north-east for one hundred yards to cairn No. 5 and on in the same direction for twenty yards to cairn No. 6; thence north-east for fifty yards to cairn No. 7; thence due north for twenty-seven yards to cairn No. 8; thence north-north-east for fifty-two yards to cairn No. 9 and on in the same direction for sixty-four yards to cairn No. 10, crossing Vidarathodu; thence due north for forty-one yards to cairn No. 11; thence north-west for fifty-nine yards to cairn No. 12; thence north-north-west for twenty-two yards to cairn No. 13; thence north-north-east for forty-seven yards to cairn No. 14; thence north-west for fifty-nine yards across a jungle stream to cairn No. 15; thence due north for seventy-three yards to cairn No. 16; thence north-north-east for sixty-six yards to cairn No. 17 and on in the same direction for fifty-seven yards to cairn No. 18; thence due north for thirty-three yards to cairn No. 19; thence north-north-west for fifty-three yards to cairn No. 20; thence due north for twenty-six yards to cairn No. 21 and on in the same direction for forty-four yards to cairn No. 22; thence north-north-west for forty-seven yards to cairn No. 23; thence due north for fifty-four yards to cairn No. 24; thence north-north-east for seventy yards to cairn No. 25; thence north-north-west for ninety-four yards to cairn No. 26; thence north-west for sixty-two yards to cairn No. 27; thence west-north-west for seventy-six yards to cairn No. 28; thence west-south-west for forty-four yards to cairn No. 29; thence west-north-west for fifty-five yards to cairn No. 30; thence north-west for forty-three yards to cairn No. 31 and on in the same direction for thirty-six yards to cairn No. 32; thence due west for twenty-eight yards to cairn No. 33 and on in the same direction for fifty-seven yards to cairn No. 34; thence west-north-west for fifty-three yards to cairn No. 35; thence north-west for forty-nine yards to cairn No. 36; thence west-north-west for seventy-six yards to cairn No. 37; thence due north for forty-six yards to cairn No. 38 and on in the same direction for fifty-five yards to cairn No. 39; thence north-north-west for thirty-three yards to cairn No. 40 and on in the same direction for forty-six yards to cairn No. 41 on the right bank of the Kumbanthodu near its source; thence along the right bank of the Kumbanthodu to its junction with the Chavachithodu; thence across the Chavachithodu and along its right bank up to its junction with the Cheenkannipoya; thence along the left bank of the latter to the starting point.

REMARK.—The following right of way is allowed within the reserve to a width of twelve feet for men and cattle:—

Public path from the Wynaad to the Kottiyur temple. It enters the reserve nine hundred yards north of the point where the boundary between the Wynaad and the Kottayam taluks is crossed by the Kuppattaran or Kunduthodu, runs in a west-north-westerly direction and quits the reserve at the ford called Eruthukadavu across the Kuradanpoya at the point where that river is joined by the Anaikulithodu from the south. The length of the path within the reserve is three miles and one and a half furlongs.

No. 445.—Under section 1 of the Madras Irrigation Cess Act, VII of 1865, as amended by Madras Act, V of 1900, His Excellency the Governor in Council is pleased to prescribe the following rules for the levy of water-rate on Government dry land in the delta tracts of the Guntur district:—

RULE I.

The water-rates charged for irrigation in these tracts will be as follow:—

- (1) For a first wet crop—one rupee per acre more than the difference between the wet and the dry rates of assessment of the land according to the classification of soil and of the source of irrigation.
- (2) For a first dry crop occasionally irrigated—half the charge in clause (1).
- (3) For a second crop of wet—
  - (i) following a first wet crop—the same charge as in clause (2) plus half the dry assessment of the land;
  - (ii) following a first dry crop occasionally irrigated—the same charge as in clause (1).
- (4) For a second dry crop occasionally irrigated—half the charge as in clause (1).
- (5) When only one wet crop is raised, the charge will be as for a first wet crop irrespective of the season in which the crop is raised.
