

The following draft of certain further amendments to the Registration of Foreigners Rules, 1939, which it is proposed to make in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 8 of the Registration of Foreigners Act, 1939 (XVI of 1939), is published, as required by the said section, for the information of all persons likely to be affected thereby and notice is hereby given that the draft will be taken into consideration on or after the 12th September 1950.

Any objections or suggestions which may be received from any person with respect to the said draft before the date specified will be considered by the Central Government.



INVESTITURE OF POWERS.

Under Section 11 of the Travancore Code of Criminal Procedure, Act VIII of 1117, as continued in force by the United State of Travancore and Cochin Administration and Application of Laws Act VI of 1125, Sri P. C. Kanniah Chettiar B. A., B. L., appointed as Tahsildar and Taluk Second Class Magistrate, Parur Taluk, is invested with the powers of a Second Class Magistrate.

East. From Pakkademettu the boundary runs along the boundaries of Madura, Ramnad and Tinnevelly Districts up to Kallimalai via Vellimalai, Kottemalai, Paohairmalai, Tolaimalai-mettu, Tottimalai, Palatumalai and Sivagiri malai.

South. From Kallimalai the boundary follows the watershed line between Periyar and Pambayar Rivers up to Uppupara via Chokampatimalai, Udamalai, Manikamalai, Sundaramalai, Nagamalai, Pachimalai, Manalkavalai and Karuvattuparamalai.

West. From Uppupara the boundary runs nearly N. N. E. along the eastern limit of S. No. 15 of Malampara Pakuthiy up to Periyar dam via Anacheruthimalai, thence first northward and thence north east along the surveyed watershed line of the streams running into Periyar Lake, up to the starting point via Kariallamala.

It is hereby notified that the area known as "Rattendon Valley" falling within the boundaries specified below is declared a Game Sanctuary and that this sanctuary called hereinafter "Annex No. 1 to the Wild Life Sanctuary" is permanently closed under sections 21 and 23 of the Travancore Forest Act II of 1968, as continued in force by the United State of Travancore-Cochin Administrations and Application of Laws Act 1125 (VI of 1125) against all shooting hunting, felling and cutting down of timber collection of forest produce, grazing of cattle and all trespass except under and with the specific orders of Government.

Taluk Peermade-

Boundaries

North: Starting from a point on the left bank of Panier situated to the west of the south east corner of S. No. 286 of Periyar Pakuthy, the boundary runs eastwards crossing the above river to the south east corner of the above S. No. thence follows the southern and eastern limits of Thangamalai and Pilased Estates till it meets the Periyar Lake Reserve boundary.

East. Thence the boundary follows the western boundary of Periyar Lake reserved Forest till it meets the Pathanamthitta Taluk boundary to the South of Periyar dam.

South. Thence the boundary follows the boundary between the Pathanamthitta and Peermade Taluks along the left bank of Periyar River up to a point where the Tanik boundary leaves the River.

West. Thence the boundary follows the left bank of Parimar river till it reaches the starting point.
