APPOINTMENT.

Ootacamund, June 3, 1914.

No. 290.—His Excellency the Governor is pleased to make the following appointment on His Excellency's Personal staff:—

No. 290.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 5 of the Madras Survey and Boundaries Act, IV of 1897. His Excellency the Governor in Council hereby orders the survey of the undermentioned lands under the provisions of the said Act :—

No. 291.—His Excellency the Governor in Council is pleased to declare under the provisions of section 16 of the Madras Forest Act, V of 1882, that, from 1st July 1914, the areas, the boundaries of which are set forth in the schedule appended to this notification, shall be constituted "reserved forest" :—

Silent Valley block.	<p><i>North.</i>—Starting from the trijunction of the three watersheds between the Kundipuzha, the Chokadpuzha and the Kotapuzha, the line runs generally eastwards along the watershed between the streams running northwards into the Kotapuzha and southwards into the Kundipuzha (over elevations 6,247 Koyipara, 6311, 7237 Siaparabetta) to the Nilgiri district boundary; thence along that boundary south—south-west and east to elevation 7664 Kovi-tholabetta; thence the same boundary south-east to the G.T.S. on Anginda Peak, elevation 7817, at the north-west corner of the Attapadi reserve.</p> <p><i>East.</i>—Thence generally southwards along the Ernad-Walavanad taluk boundary, being the western boundary of the Attapadi reserve to the south-west corner of the latter on Aruvamparai, elevation 3812.</p> <p><i>South.</i>—Thence generally westwards along the ridge running down to the Kundipuzha river to a cairn at the top of the cliff on the east side of the Kundipuzha gorge; thence in a straight line to the trijunction point of survey No. 1/1-B of Payyanadam and survey Nos. 51/3-A and 51/3-C both of Kandamangalam; thence in the same straight line along the north side of the last-named field to its north-west corner; thence its west side to the quadrangle junction point of survey Nos. 51/3-C, 51/3-A, 51/2-C and 51/2-A all of Kandamangalam; thence the north side of the last named field to the trijunction point of survey Nos. 51/2-A, 51/2-C and 51/2-B all of Kandamangalam at the G.T.S. on Vannamparai elevation 3696.</p> <p><i>West.</i>—Thence the east sides of survey Nos. 51/2-B and 51/3-E, both of Kandamangalam to Kalliparai, elevation 3649 on the Ernad-Walavanad taluk boundary; thence northwards along the cliffs to Udamparai, elevation 3580; thence westwards along the cliffs over Sembukatti to Kulika Mudi, elevation 3468; thence in a straight line west-south-west to Puvamalai; thence in a straight line south-west to Ponmudi on the Ernad-Walavanad taluk boundary; thence westwards along the boundary to Madamudi, elevation 3818; thence north-west along the watershed between the streams running westwards into the Pulianthodu and eastwards into the Palakazhipuzha, still along the taluk boundary to the trijunction of the three watersheds between the streams running into the Pulianthodu, the Palakazhipuzha (and Valakayan thodu, its tributary) and the Olipuzha; thence northwards, along the watershed, between the streams running into the two last named rivers to Valia Perumban Kumban, shown on Government of India Survey map as Cherumban Kumban, elevation 3813; thence east-north-east to Cheria Perumban Kumban; thence in a straight line north-east to Komba Sholai malai; thence north to Kathiandan on the watershed between the streams running westwards into the Olipuzha, Pallasberithodu and Chokadpuzha rivers and eastwards into the Kundipuzha; thence along the last named watershed generally northwards (over elevations 4152, 4084, Valia Mullamalai, 5091 Siriaputhuvamudi) to the starting point.</p>
