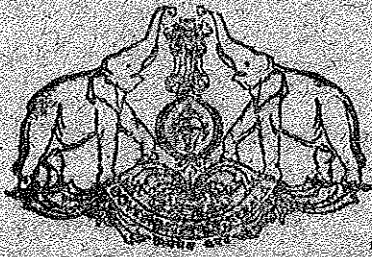

Whereas the Government of Kerala has published Act No. 21 of 2005, namely, the Kerala Forest (Vestment and Management of Ecologically Fragile Lands) Act 2003, which came into effect from 2nd day of June 2003 for the Conservation and Management of Ecologically Fragile Lands, minimizing the reduction or degradation of the Eco-System and Biological Diversity therein.

Now, it is hereby notified for the information of the public that the ownership and possession of the lands as per the details shown in the Schedule hereto, in the District of Palakkad have been vested with Government of Kerala free from all encumbrances and the right, title and interest of the owner or any other person thereon shall stand extinguished from the date of commencement of the Act, i.e. 2nd June 2000.

The publication of this notification is made as required under section 3 (2) of the Kerala Forest (Vestment and Management of Ecologically Fragile Lands) Act, 2003 as per Government Notification No. 15567/L/BI/01/Law dated 3rd May, 2005 and published in Kerala Gazette No. 929, dated 3rd May 2005.

TENDER CUM AUCTION NOTICE

1. It is hereby notified for the information of the public that the right of collection and removal of standing Elavu, Albezia and Vatta trees in the 1965 MW Plantation, South series (12.447 ha.) and 1965 MW plantation North series (15.929 ha.) of Achencovil Range of this Division as specified in the schedule appended below will be sold in tender-cum-auction by the Divisional Forest Officer, Achencovil or any other Officers authorized by him on 8-3-2007 at 3 p.m. in the Divisional Forest Office, Achencovil, at the risk and loss of the original bidders Sri. M. A. Majeed, Akbar Nivas, Pangodu P. O. Thiruvananthapuram, and Sri. A. K. Raju, Rehuvilasam, Aikkarakonam, Punalur respectively. In addition to the above the trees specified in the schedule standing in block No. 6 and 7 (10 ha. each) coming in 1967 MW plantation, Alinjamon will also be sold in the public tender/auction on the same date at the same place and time mentioned in the schedule subject to the terms and conditions of sale of timber in Government Timber Depots published in Government Gazette No. 50 dated 20-12-2005, Page No. 389 to 394 of Forest Sheet as per Pro. (5)-5370/2005 dated 28-11-2005 of the Chief Conservator of Forests (P), Thiruvananthapuram and Government Gazette No. 5 dated 31-1-2006 vide Page No. 66 as per Pro. (5)-5370/05 dated 13-1-2006 of the Chief Conservator of Forests (P), Thiruvananthapuram and as per general conditions of the sale of tree growth prevailing in the department. In case the notified date happens to be a public holiday, the Tender/Sale will be conducted on the next working day at the notified place and time.

2. The auction will be on lumpsum basis for the right of collection and removal of entire Elavu, Albezia and Vatta tree growth from the above plantations/blocks mentioned in the schedule hereto the area of which has been surveyed and demarcated on the ground.

3. Intending Tenderers/Bidders may inspect the trees and satisfy themselves of the quantity and quality of the produce before participating in the Tender/Auction. Complaints if any regarding quality and quantity etc. received after the Tender/Auction will not be entertained.

4. Bidder should appear for the auction in person and nobody will be permitted to bid on behalf of another unless valid power of attorney is produced prior to commencement of Auction/Tender.

5. A contractor of Achencovil Division or the adjacent Divisions will not be allowed to bid in the Auction/Tender.

6. Intending Tenderers/Bidders should produce a certificate from the concerned Village Officer showing their permanent address and duly attesting their signature along with Earnest Money Deposit.

7. The successful Tenderers/Bidders should give an undertaking that he is not related to any officer having control of the work and that he is not supply contractor of this or any adjacent divisions. If this is proved otherwise it shall result in cancellation of the contract and resale of the coupe at his risk and loss.
