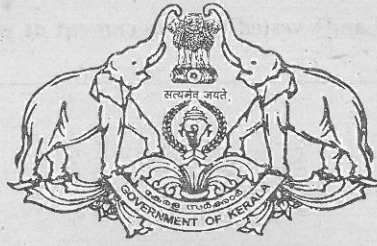

WHEREAS, the Government of Kerala has published Act No. 21 of 2005, namely, the Kerala Forest (Vesting and Management of Ecologically Fragile Lands) Act, 2003, which came into effect from 2nd day of June 2000 for the conservation and management of Ecologically Fragile Lands, minimizing the reduction of degradation of the Eco-System and Biological Diversity therein.

Now, it is hereby notified for the information of the public that the ownership and possession of the land as per the details shown in the schedule hereto, in the District of Thrissur has been vested with the Government of Kerala free from all encumbrances and the right, title and interest of the owner or any other person thereon shall stand extinguished from the date of commencement of the Act, i.e. 2nd June 2000.

The publication of the notification is made as required under Section 3(2) of the Kerala Forest (Vesting and Management of Ecologically Fragile Lands) Act, 2003 as per Government Notification No. 15567/Leg. B1/01/Law dated 3rd May 2005 and published in Kerala Gazette No. 929 dated 3rd May 2005.

It is hereby notified for the information of the public that the Teak Poles collected from 1965, 1973, 1974 and 1975 Teak Plantations Mammoodupathal in Vadasserikkara Range, 1968 Teak Plantation Pampavally in Ranni Range and Teak Timber and Teak Poles collected from 1968 Teak Plantation Veluthodu in Goodrickal Range of Ranni Division as shown in the schedule given below will be sold in public Tender-cum-auction at dumping sites shown in the schedule by the Divisional Forest Officer, Ranni or any officer authorised by him, subject to the conditions published in Kerala Gazette No. 49 dated 14-12-2010 vide Notification No. Pro (5) 5628/08 dated 4-12-2010 of the Chief Conservator of Forests (P); Thiruvananthapuram and other conditions prevalent in the Forest Department.
