III. Nidil-Megarubail foot-path, to a width of six feet, for men and cattle; enters the reserve forty-five yards north of cairu No. 36, runs in a west-north-westerly direction about one sud-a-half furlongs and quits it on the north side of cairu No. 164.

IV.
